Terms and Conditions

- 1. Squad fees are based on a 39-week training year for coaching sessions.
- 2. A deposit (to the value of 1 month's payment) is taken upon successful application. A further 11 monthly payments are scheduled for the 1st of each month starting September 2025. The final payment will be scheduled for 1st July 2026. These payments cover services delivered between 1st September 2025 and 31st August 2026.
- 3. The Funded Programme is a one year commitment. Players wishing to leave the programme before the end of this agreement must give a minimum of **3 months' notice** in writing. This can be via email to James (james.langford@bromleytenniscentre.co.uk).
- 4. A player can be removed from their programme with immediate effect at the discretion of management. In this instance, future scheduled payments will be cancelled.
- 5. Should payment not be made in accordance with the payment plan, the player's programme will be stopped immediately.
- 6. In the event of a failed scheduled payment we will attempt to re-run the payment the following day at no extra charge. In the event of a 3rd failed payment, a £50 processing fee will be added to the cost of that month's payment.
- 7. In the event of having to take recovery action for payment, an administration charge of £80 + VAT will be applied plus the costs incurred for the recovery.
- 8. Any discounts or rebates are entirely at the discretion of Bromley Tennis Centre management and there are no refunds for training absences other than at the Centre's discretion. Prolonged injury or illness are subject to the normal terms and conditions displayed in the reception area and discretion of management.
- 9. Players and their parents are expected to attend relevant presentations by BTC staff and external speakers.
- 10. Package players are expected to be available for National League teams (in collaboration with other Kent clubs), matches are April June. Selections are made in January so discuss with James if there are any extenuating circumstances that will rule you out of selection. Players are expected to be available for at least 75% of the fixtures whether home or away and regardless of other competitions.
- 11. Courts for individual lessons are scheduled and will have been arranged already with your coach. Individual courts as part of the RPDC package are non-refundable and cannot be used as a credit if cancelled by the player. If a coach cancels a lesson and no alternative coach can be found, courts will be returned as a credit. Extra individual lessons can be booked directly with the coach.
- 12. Media policy: BTC is involved in local and national media. By signing this contract, you are agreeing to your child's image and likeness being used in any photos or videos. Please confirm with us in writing if you **do not** give permission for your child's image to be used in any promotional material.
- 13. Players and parents are expected to behave in a professional manner and support BTC at the Centre and at other venues and value the reputation of BTC and any associated coaches. By signing this agreement, the player and parents confirm that they have read and understood the Player Standards of Conduct and Parent Standards of Conduct documents shared with you.
